



The Right Way to measure your pet.

Making 100% sure that your pet is measured correctly will ensure their ultimate comfort, your peace of mind, and an accurate quote!

- 1. Having a pencil handy, stand your pet against a wall or plain, solid surface. Ensure the surface is upright and stable.
- 2. Make sure your pet's posture is natural, yet straight. Neck must be held comfortably.
- 3. Using the pencil, mark the wall at the uppermost tip of your pet's ears, the tip of the nose and the end of his back (excluding the tail).
 - a. To indicate height, measure the distance from the floor to the mark at the tip of the ears.
 - b. To indicate length, measure the distance between the nose mark and the mark at your pet's bum.
 - c. To indicate width, measure the distance between the left and the right shoulder.
 - d. An important measurement to take is the length from the pet's elbow to the floor. This is called "height from elbow joint".
- 4. Weighing your pet is easiest if you pick them up, and take down your weight combined with the pets' weight by using a bathroom scale. Then, accurately weigh yourself, and subtract your weight from the combined weight to get your pet's weight.
- 5. Accurately complete the attached form with all the details and submit to your agent for processing.
